Matrah is designed emphasizing three modular elements: a structural metal frame, a seat and a backrest-armrest. The easychair enhances smooth and flawed lines.

Its welcoming shapes are designed to

hold our body harmoniously, setting aside our digital devices. A special attention is given to the durability of the product: it is possible to remove the cover of the padding, allowing easy maintenance.


































Matrah finds its fulfillment in the artisan wool production, typical of the area, which enhances the intrinsic characteristics of the sheep wool.

improve its materiality and consistency, thus enriching and enhancing the multisensory experience.


The textile material enhances the strong character of an endangered sheep.












From the wool, obtained by a humble sheep breed, the Gentile di Puglia, originally from Southern Italy, a high-quality textile is manufactured.

Rustic to the touch, with a characteristic natural smell, the wool brings with it small

plant fragments, the soul of the areas. This project aims at preserving what would otherwise be disposed of, stimulating the restore of biodiversity in the inland landscapes, collaborating for cohesion and social well-being.
